""Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the tomb." John 20:1

We sometimes feel that we live in tombs of depression, despair, and sorrow; tombs of exile, oppression, and sin, all of which weigh us down like death in a tomb. God rolls away the stones from the entrance to the tombs of our lives so that we can see for ourselves the light of Jesus. This past Easter was no exception. God is still rolling away stones even yet today.

On Easter Sunday Jesus rose again and lives still. God is still rolling stones even yet today. We are Easter people.

Easter people, raise your voices, sounds of heaven in earth should ring. Every day to us is Easter, with its resurrection song.
