Moncks Corner UMC has been ministering to our community recently with several mission projects and opportunities. In June we hosted Vacation Bible School. Our children's ministry leaders and many others worked diligently to offer VBS for the children of our church and community. Over 40 children were present to hear the Bible stories and sings songs and make crafts to learn more about Jesus and the Bible.

More recently, the second week of July, MCUMC was host once again to the Salkehatchie group. Many workers from around the state as well as right here in our church helped to make Salkehatchie and success again this year. Two houses received their much-needed repairs. The workers were fed and housed efficiently as they worked in building the kingdom of God right here in our community.

We have another opportunity for mission as we collect school supplies to fill backpacks for the children of our community. There are boxes in the church office and foyer to the sanctuary to put the supplies in during the month of July.

The missions committee is also initiating a new project later this year with Undue Medical Debt who purchase and forgives the medical debts of those whose income is 4 times the federal poverty limit or less, or whose medical dets are 5% or more of their annual income.
