"The Stones of Lent" Worship Series

At the time you are receiving this newsletter, we are almost halfway through the Lenten season. We have been experiencing "The Stones of Lent" Worship Series as a part of our Sunday morning worship services. We are hearing stories in the Bible that involve stones in some way, however, the meaning of the stories is not about stones.

So far we have heard about precious stones and changing stones. We will also hear about throwing stones, rejected stones, living stones, shouting stones, and rolling stones. All of these stones are reflecting the stories of the acts of Jesus in his ministry. Several of the stories tell of his journey to the cross in preparation for completing his earthly ministry. The story of Easter moves us toward the continuing journey of Jesus' ministry that will be completed after we have all been resurrected into the eternal life that only Jesus offers.

You are having the opportunity to share these stories as you collect stones each Sunday to give away to people who you know, as well as to place around the community to share the story of Jesus.

Tell me the stories of Jesus I love to hear: things I would ask him to tell me if he were here: scenes by the wayside, tales of the sea, words full of kindness, deeds full of grace, all in the lovelight of Jesus' face, stories of Jesus, tell them to me.
