

Missions COMMITTEE

November and December were busy months in Missions! Our church is so supportive of whatever we do to be the hands and feet of Jesus in our community so thank you so much for your support!

The <u>Thanksgiving Boxes</u> of food were delivered to 10 families at each Moncks Corner and Berkeley Elementary Schools, and Berkeley Middle School. The Guidance Counselors expressed so much gratitude for the food for these needy families!

December was the **Angel Tree**! Our church made Christmas morning brighter for 50 children in our community! So many of the parents were amazed at the generosity of our church. Feed Berkeley is our on-going ministry.

Feed Berkeley was formed during Covid by a consortium of churches in our community to supply families in our community with a shelf-stable box of food and fresh produce when available. Our church serves on the third Saturday of the month. In 2024, Feed Berkeley distributed food on 44 Saturdays, serving 3,590 families or 11,488 family members. Since we started keeping records in 2021, Feed Berkeley has served over 35,000 residents in our community! Thank you to our congregation for your financial support and for your service!

We will be having our <u>Souper Bowl of Caring</u> in the Fellowship Hall after church on February 9th . Souper Bowl of Caring was a fund-raising drive to fight hunger that started at a SC church. It has grown and now falls under a larger umbrella of Tackle Hunger which is a nation-wide non-profit dedicated to fighting food insecurity. Donations from our event will benefit Feed Berkeley, our local food bank that strives to feed our community both physically and spiritually. We will be taking donations in church and in the Fellowship Hall on the 9th, but donations can also be made ahead of the event with a check payable to the church and designated for Souper Bowl of Caring.

Vonnie HAMER's Cream of Broccoli Soup

6 chicken bullion cubes 6 Tbsp butter or margarine

1 small onion chopped fine 6 Tbsp flour

1 large bunch broccoli 1 lb Velveeta cheese

Cook together the water, chicken bullion cubes, onion and broccoli for at least 30 minutes. Melt butter in saucepan, adding flour to make a smooth consistency. Add to cooked ingredients, stirring constantly. Add cheese, again stirring well until melted. Add milk. Heat until hot but do NOT bring to a boil.


