


Vacation BIBLE School

Blessing BAG Project

At the May meeting, the Women in Mission (WIM) assembled 100 bags in less than 45 minutes for The Blessing Bag Project at Ekklesia! One of the ladies said, "I feel like Lucy and Ethel (in an episode of 'I Love Lucy') on the assembly line of the chocolate factory. "Lots of love and laughter went into those bags and for the WIM it was a fun night of being the hands and feet of Christ.

The Blessing Bags are like the goodies bag that you take home after the party, only these bags contain items we often take for granted in our daily lives but are often like gold to someone who is homeless. These Bags contain a canned good meal, toilet paper, snacks, water, laundry pods and hygiene items like shampoo, soap, toothpaste and a toothbrush.

The Blessing Bag Project at Ekklesia is a non-profit dedicated to serving the homeless in our community. Their mission is "feeding the homeless, spiritually and physically, one Bible and bag at a time." The Blessing Bag Project collaborates with other organizations who together provide clothes, a hot meal, showers, laundry services and haircuts for the homeless at various locations in the Tri-county area. We know "the least of these" feel the love of Christ at these events and hope they feel the love of the Women in Mission as they receive one of the goodie bags that we packed for them.
